Cornwall Council Leader confirms membership of new Cabinet.

7 June 2017

Cornwall Council Leader Adam Paynter has today formally confirmed the members of the authority's new Cabinet and the allocation of the individual portfolios.

The membership of the Cabinet, which reflects the alliance between the Independent and Liberal Democrat Groups to form the new administration, comprises five Liberal Democrats and five Independents.

The five Liberal Democrat councillors nominated to the Cabinet and their portfolio areas are:
